3.2 PSD will continue to obtain the information from CPA as to when sealed pesticide containers were introduced.	PSD	CPA reported that this type of container - 'Surefill' - was first introduced in 1997, and migration from boxes to 'Surefill' would have taken place up to 2000.
3.6 Ideas sought for information that could be included in a newsletter circulated between meetings.	ALL	Any ideas to be sent to PSD.
3.7 SEERAD (now RERAD) will obtain information of any Scottish prosecutions. And PSD will do the same for any successful Welsh prosecutions.	RERAD/PSD	Still to action for Scotland. None for Wales.
