3.1.1 HSE & SEERAD to report on their assessment of how incidents of two approved use cases in 2005 affected the products approval.	HSE & SEERAD	HSE have informed Approval Holder of this. No further action taken due to issues associated with the use of such rodenticides.
3.1.1 CPA will confirm when sealed pesticide containers were introduced.	CPA	
5.5 PSD will investigate the development of maps and CSL will forward electronic maps circulated for information at the meeting to PSD for distribution to interested parties.	CSL/PSD	CSL have produced maps for 2006 data, which appeared on the PSD website on the 3 May 2007. At the 13 September 2006 meeting, it was agreed that maps were a clear way to explain the distribution of pesticide poisoning cases in the various areas.
6.1 PSD will consider suggestions for promoting the Campaign in 2007.	PSD	Barbara Bell, ADAS is producing a program for 2007 with web/leaflets/posters. There will be less of an emphasis on attending shows with greater efforts directed at alternative methods of publicity.

PSD	E-mailed alerts sent out with links to the web, when quarterly reports have been published. Care needs to be taken providing information relating to 'live' cases as this could prejudice enforcement actions.
